(2) Itemized schedule of expenses are attached. We have reconstructed past years' expenses to the best of available records, mostly from canceled checks. Attached are reports from 2005, 2004, and 2003. If earlier records are also required, we'll try to reconstruct those year's too. Line 15 corresponds to our category of "Donations". Line 20 corresponds to our category of "Facilities". Excess amounts from each year were kept in our none interest-bearing checking account. Beginning in 2004, we also

made deposit into CD accounts. As of March, 2006. WCCF has approximately \$50,000 in the checking account, \$20,000 in CDs.

(3) Lease agreement Community Bible Church. We do not have any formal lease or rental agreement with CBC as such. Our relationship began in the mid 70's. At first, WCCF met in CBC for Friday evening Bible study. Several families attended. By late 70's, it included a Sunday afternoon service. Money issues were never discussed, even to this day. However, from the very beginning, we have made free-will contributions to CBC on a monthly basis, from the offerings collected by WCCF. From memory, our monthly donation was around \$400 in the early 80's. Today it is \$800. From time to time, we also made other donations to CBC. Most often to defray the winter heating and snow removal cost. One year, we donated some more money after CBC paved the parking lot. In 2005, CBC began a renovation project to improve the building's physical access. This project is still on-going. We discussed this over several monthly co-worker's meeting, and contributed \$15,000 towards that work.
